

- Quality of Life Improvements: Discussing the ways in which CSR initiatives enhance the overall quality of life for communities, including access to clean water, sanitation, healthcare, education, and cultural activities.
- Role of Technology in Creating Impact via Social Projects: How new technologies including Al, Machine Learning, Data Science can be leveraged to enhance the impact of social initiatives, such as using data analytics to track progress and measure impact, or using digital platforms to connect with beneficiaries and stakeholders.
- Workshops on designing sustainable and long-term social initiatives: Hands-on workshops on how to create CSR programs that make a real difference. These workshops will provide practical guidance on designing CSR initiatives that tackle local yet crucial issues, having a positive impact on the communities.






